- Control components such as flow switches, pressure switches and sensors

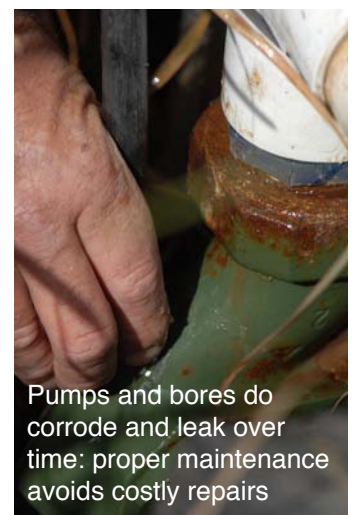
We would usually check the above at least every quarter, every month or seasonally.
